

Plants from around the world:

Africa: watermelon

Asia: dianthus, garlic (rocambole), horseradish, hosta, rhubarb, sorrel

Europe: asparagus, cardoon, dianthus, horseradish, sorrel

North America: strawberrytomatillo

South America: potato
