
## **HUMMINGBIRD GARDEN**



Items in blue font are perennials that are great for attracting hummingbirds with their tubular flowers filled with nectar. Those shown in red are annual plants that serve the same purpose. Although they are lower on the list of favored hummingbird plants, single flowered zinnias are much more attractive to our flighy friends than are the large double-flowered types. We've included two large golden zinnias for you to compare. Although hummingbirds are attracted to red blooms, they also feed freely at tubular blooms of other colors such as the blue salvia, purple liatris, and purple nicotiana.
